By eScooter

There are several eScooters available in Kiel for shorter distances. Providers include Tier, Bolt and Pferd. The eScooters can be parked almost anywhere in the city centre. Please ensure that the scooters do not obstruct traffic, whether pedestrians, cyclists, motorists or other road users.

By e-Motorbike „emmy“

If you have a driving licence, you also have the option of renting an e-motorbike. Two people can even ride at the same time on the e-motorbikes.

By bike „Sprottenflotte“

If you don't have your own bike with you, you can also use the bikes from „Sprottenflotte“ in Kiel. Download the Donkey Republic App and find out which stations there are to hire and return your bike. The first half hour is free of charge.

By bus

The best way to get from Kiel Central Station to Schilksee is to take the bus. Lines 12, 13 and X30 run at regular intervals, as does the N12 at night. You can choose either „Olympiazentrum“ or „Drachenbahn“ as the final stop.

By train

Via train you can get to Kiel Central Station, e.g. from Hamburg or from the north coming from Denmark. Many buses leave directly in front of the main station and will take you to Schilksee. For train connections you can check [bahn.de](#)

By ferry

If you allow enough time, you can also take the ferry to Schilksee a few times a day.

By plane and by bus „Kielius“

If you are travelling by plane, you will land at Hamburg Airport. From there you can take the train to Kiel, or you can take the airport bus „Kielius“.
